TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Be on the lookout!

Travel documents were sent by Fed Ex to the mailing address on your registration form. **You should receive them in 2-3 days.**



WHAT'S IN MY TRAVEL DOCS

Within your travel documents are your flight itinerary, airline reservation confirmation # (needed to look up your flights), a Welcome Booklet, bag tags, and travel insurance confirmation sheet.

NAMES MUST MATCH

Make sure the names on your flight itinerary match your passports. These are the names that will be on your boarding passes and MUST MATCH your passport* or you may not be able to board your flights. If names don't match, please contact Cornerstone Travel Group ASAP.

*NOTE: Suffixes and titles, even if listed on passport, are NOT necessary to include.



VALID PASSPORT

A valid passport is required for traveling to Costa Rica and must remain valid throughout your stay in the country.*
